The IHA PAC is the political action committee (PAC) of the Iowa Hospital Association (IHA). The committee was started in 1990 to promote and facilitate voluntary contributions from IHA members to support candidates for elective office. The IHA PAC is a state PAC. Monies raised through the IHA PAC are used to support elected officials and state candidates who listen to the perspectives of Iowa hospitals and champion IHA's public policy priorities concerning hospitals and the delivery of high-quality health care. The IHA PAC is also a collecting agent for the American Hospital Association (AHA) federal PAC that supports the election of candidates for federal offices. The IHA PAC is nonpartisan and supports members, elected officials and candidates despite party affiliation.

Having a PAC enables IHA to fully engage on public policy issues to protect the interests of lowa hospitals and create critical relationships.

A strong PAC ensures that your voice is heard.

MESSAGE FROM THE 2020 IHA PAC CHAIR



I am pleased to present the IHA PAC 2020 Annual Report detailing the commitment of IHA members in safeguarding the sustainability and success of Iowa hospitals. Even in a year that no one could have imagined, steadfast hospital leaders pushed forward with their hospital campaigns and personal contributions—remarkable when you consider members' challenges with the pandemic and the derecho.

IHA's PAC outperformed many peer state hospital associations in raising nearly \$113,000 in contributions. Some states didn't solicit at all and others scaled back their campaigns. Iowa was among nine states that met their American Hospital Association (AHA) goal, and just 13 state hospital association PACs raised more than Iowa.

In 2021, we'll need to double-down to add to the PAC reserves. We have been losing ground in the past few years in not meeting the annual goal. And that has impact. Campaign contributions this past year were less than half of those made in the 2018 election cycle. The 2020 IHA PAC was limited to \$104,000 in campaign contributions compared to \$216,000 in 2018.

IHA PAC dollars go to state lawmakers and candidates who stand with us on issues that matter most. With your IHA PAC contribution, we can continue to build meaningful relationships and promote policies that advance and support lowa's hospitals and health systems. One hundred twenty-three members united can have a tremendous impact on our advocacy efforts!

IHA POLITICAL ACTION CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE

The IHA PAC Committee sets and approves the annual statewide PAC goal and individual hospital goals. Committee members provide input and feedback to help raise funds from members and, in consultation with the IHA legislative team, the Committee also approves PAC disbursements.

The IHA PAC Committee is composed of IHA member hospital and health system CEOs. Each of IHA's five geographic districts is represented by their respective residing District Chair. Four at-large committee members are appointed by the Executive Committee that is comprised of the immediate past IHA Board chair who chairs the PAC Committee, the vice chair of the IHA Board, and the IHA President and CEO. The current IHA Board Chair is an ex-officio member of the committee. Committee members serve one-year terms and meet via conference call throughout the year.

- Federal AHAPAC received \$27,350 from Iowa.









IHA STAFF CAMPAIGN

IHA staff raised **\$21,000** in its 2020 campaign. It is the most money ever raised since the PAC started in 1990.

IHA's campaign has topped all individual hospital campaigns five times since 2010.
